The videos are short, with most ranging from 20 seconds to 6 minutes in length, so it's easy for children to watch a variety of them—or to re-watch a favorite several times.



 - -Slimezilla vs The Compound Words: A compound word is when two words come together and make a new word (e.g., sun and shine =sunshine)
 - **Pancake Panic- Homophones:** A homophone is a word that sounds the same as another word or words, but has a different meaning and spelling (e.g., eight and ate, or blue and blew).
 - -Sight Word Bingo: Pick a grade level sight word list (pre-primer, primer, first, second). Listen to the sight word and find it on the bingo board.
