- **Math 7**
 - Grade level curriculum aligned to NYS Standards
- **Math 7 Accelerated**
 - Covers curriculum of Math 7 & Math 8
 - Precedes Algebra (high school credit bearing course) in 8th grade

World Languages

- **Spanish, Chinese, French, American Sign Language**
- 7th Grade=Level 1A
- 8th Grade=Level 1B
- At the end of 8th grade, students will take the Checkpoint A exam
- The successful completion of a language in grades 7 and 8 marks the completion of Level 1 and allows students to take 2R or 2H in grade 9
 - Earn 1 credit for HS
- This will be the language your child continues with to satisfy their language requirement for graduation.

Looking Ahead...

Acceleration Options in 8th grade

➤ Algebra 1

- Replaces Math 8
- Can only be taken if student takes Math 7 ACC in 7th grade

➤ Earth and Space Science + Lab

- Replaces Science 8 and includes a lab every other day

➤ Studio Art

- Every day for the full year; can indicate interest next year

➤ Geometry (Double Accelerated)

Each accelerated course will earn one high school credit towards graduation and will appear on your child's high school transcript (final average and Regents Exam score).

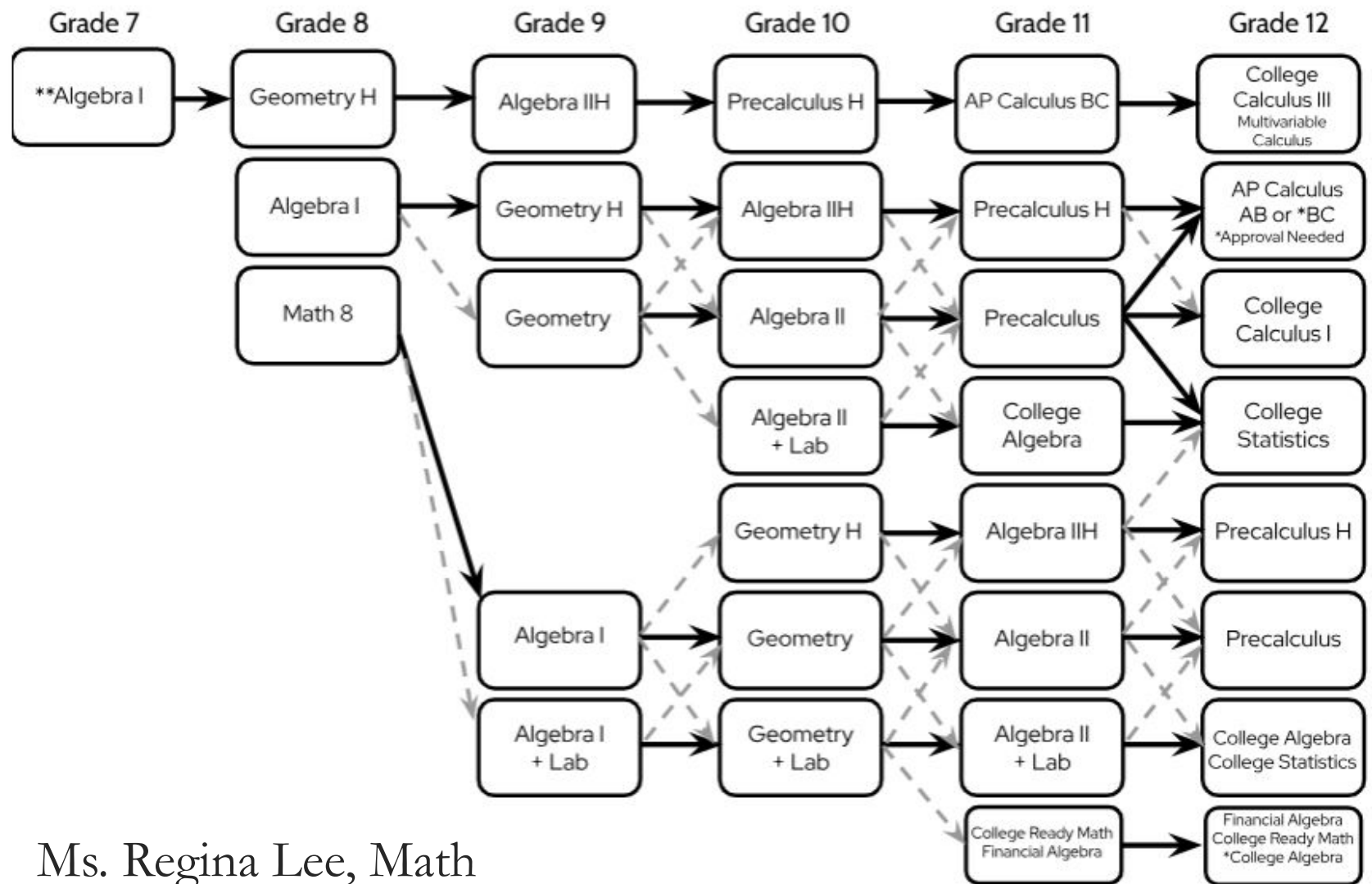

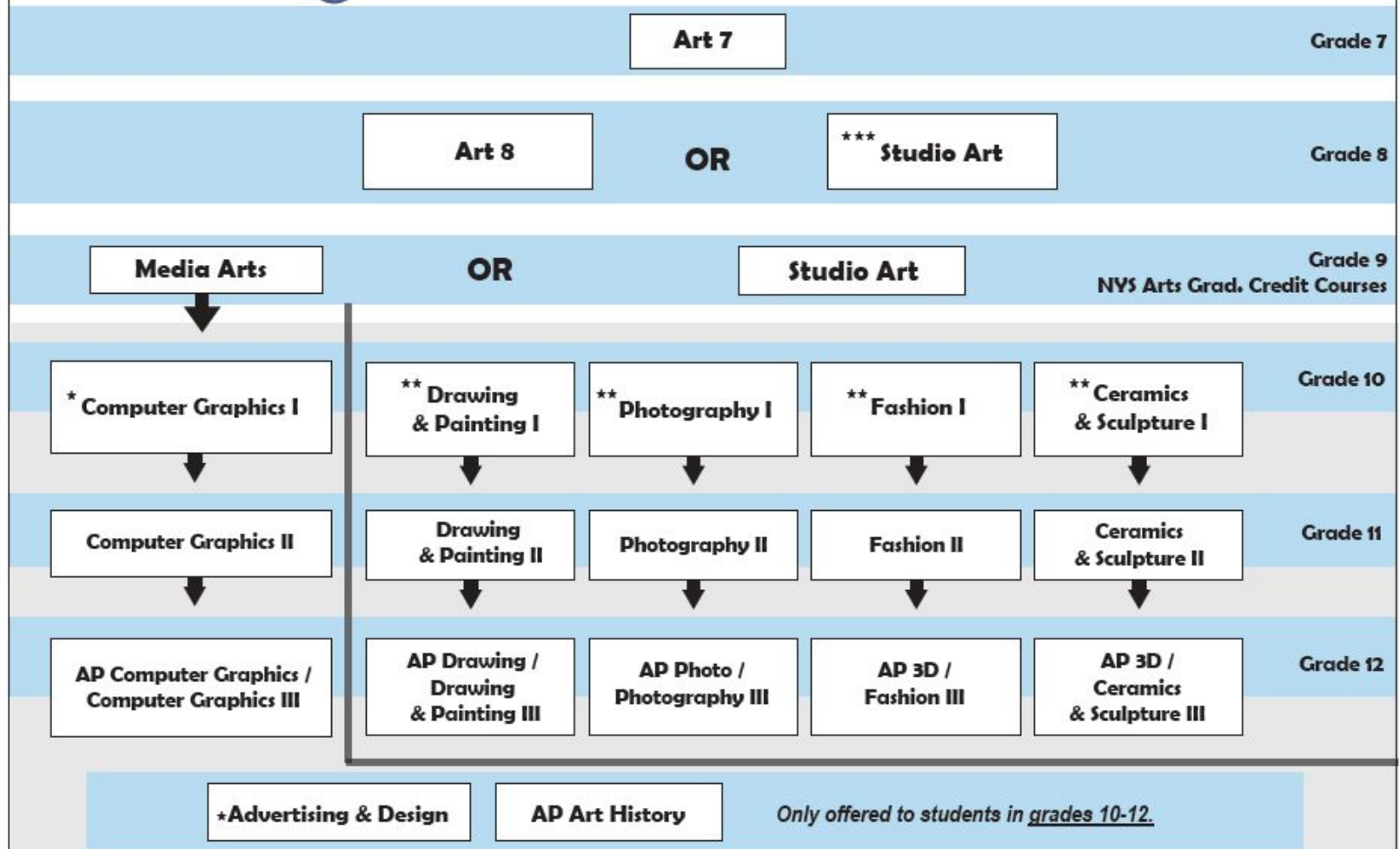
